Cook and Ford were successors to McDowell and Cook in 1873, and they conducted a manufacturing and repairing business until October 1884. Mr. Ford then operated the business alone until January 1886 when the firm consisting of P. H. Ford and R. E. Thorn took charge as Ford and Thorn. Runk, Brown and Company, writing in 1888, make the following statements: "A two-story frame building, 60 by 120 feet, conveniently divided into suitable apartments, is now occupied. A large local trade is supplied with the products of the Excelsior Works and the Milburn Wagon, for which the firm are agents.
