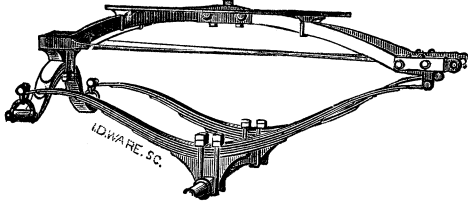

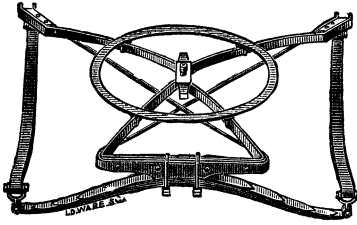

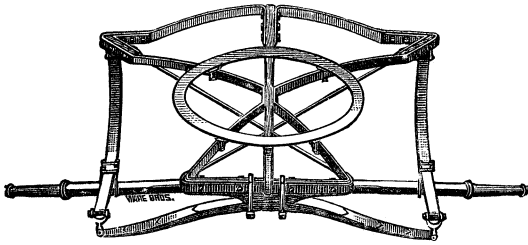

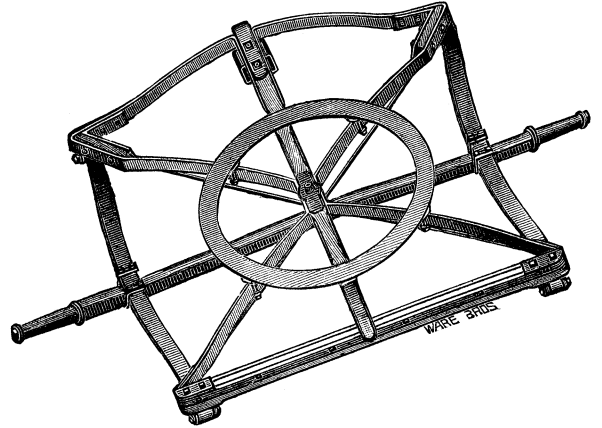
SIDE VIEW OF PLATFORM.
